

Local Government Reorganisation

- There are two simultaneous initiatives
- Local Government Reorganisation aimed at reducing bureaucracy by replacing the current two-tier system with one Unitary Council
- Devolution Transference of funding and powers from Whitehall to local regional authorities

Hampshire County Council and Eastleigh District Council will be replaced by one authority. HCC is being fast tracked, a fast-moving process.
